Through work with the community and the environment, the charity's main aims are to conserve resources by recycling surplus household and commercial items; which are then passed back to the community to alleviate poverty to underprivileged families and individuals in need. Track 2000 undertakes the largest community based waste minimisation programme in their areas.

Senior Management at Track 2000 understands that their operations have an impact on the local and global environment and is committed to achieving effective environmental management to ensure pollution prevention from all activities.

Track 2000 is committed to:

- Continual Environmental Improvement through the development of an ongoing environmental action plan.

- Ongoing re-using and recycling household and commercial items for supply for those in need. This assures a substantial tonnage is diverted away from landfill every year.

- Maintaining close contact with Regulatory bodies to ensure all practices on and off site are always within the industry best practice.
